Delaware County Office for the Aging Announces merge with the Rural Health Network of South Central New York to operate the Non-Emergency Medical Transportation Program!

Beginning October 1, 2025, any individual aged 60 and older who needs transportation to and from a medical appointment will be able to call the Get There Call Center and schedule a ride through the Volunteer Transportation Service. The phone number to schedule a ride is 1-855-373-4040.

Previously, individuals could contact the Office for Aging and have their rides coordinated. The program will continue to operate in the same manner, with many of the same volunteer drivers, but will be coordinated through Get There's call center.
