On June 20, 2020, Governor Andrew Cuomo signed Executive Order 203, NYS Police Reform & Reinvention Collaborative. As required, the Chairman of the Delaware County Board of Supervisors convened a committee to develop a plan that reviews and is tailored to the specific needs of the community. This plan will foster and improve the relationship between the community and the Delaware County Sheriff's Office. The Delaware County Police Reform and Reinvention Collaborative committee held a virtual meeting on Monday, January 18th, at 11am. This meeting was livestreamed and is available for viewing on the Delaware County NY YouTube channel.
